2. Susan began reading a TumbleBook which was 20 pages long. She has already read 5 pages.

**How many more pages does Susan need to read to finish the TumbleBook?**

3. Mahar started reading his TumbleBook at 9:00 in the morning. When he finished his TumbleBook he looked up at the clock and it read 9:14.

**How long did it take Mahar to read the TumbleBook?**

4. Ellie has read her favorite TumbleBook 4 times in one week. Stuart has read his favorite TumbleBook 6 times in two weeks.

**Who will have read their favorite TumbleBook the most after 4 weeks?**

5. In Mr. Berg's class, each student gets to use the computer for 30 minutes each day. Juan is looking forward to his turn to read his Tumblebook on-line. He must wait for Carmen to finish her turn on the computer.

**Carmen began her turn at 10:15. What time will it be when it is Juan's turn on the computer?**
